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1. Wisdom: It is having an understanding of a certain area or situation. It is being able to understand the concept with Divine knowledge. Having practical knowledge to apply.

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2. Knowledge: Knowledge of what? From the Word of God! BY the Spirit. This means you must walk in the Spirit to be able to share the knowledge of the Holy Spirit, that comes from God out of the throne room of God.

3. Faith: Have faith that can move mountains.

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9. Interpretation of Tongues: A Language Not of the Earth but for the Body of Christ

Translation deals with **written** content, while **interpretation** deals with **spoken** or signed content. **Translation** is a **text-based** process that allows for time, research, and refinement, whereas **interpretation** is real-time, requiring quick **thinking** and immediate delivery of a **spoken** message.

1Co 13:1 If I speak in the tongues of men and of angels, but have not love, I am only a resounding gong or a clanging cymbal.

1Co 13:2 If I have the gift of prophecy and can fathom all mysteries and all knowledge, and if I have a faith that can move mountains, but have not love, I am nothing.

1Co 13:3 If I give all I possess to the poor and surrender my body to the flames, but have not love, I gain nothing.

1Co 13:4 Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud.

1Co 13:5 It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs.
